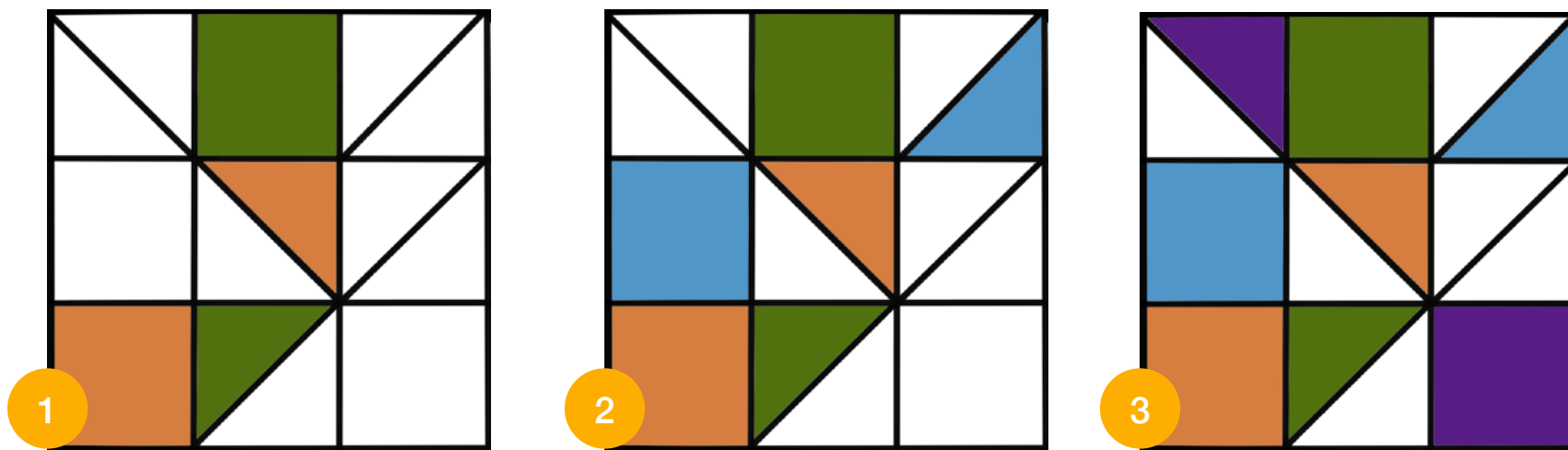




# KITE

*instructions*



To complete this kit, I used various settings of the 5.5mm lator punch needle. You can play around with the settings to see what you like best. Since they're not marked you can set it to the second hole from the top so you'll only see one above the handle.

- (1) Thread your punch needle with the mustard yarn and punch the triangle (I used a longer setting) and then the square (I used a shorter setting). Then repeat with the green yarn.
- (2) Move on to blue yarn and continue in the same fashion.
- (3) Keep going until you use all colors. Lastly, use cream yarn. The length of loops in the cream section are all up to you! I did them all on the shortest setting so that the colorful parts would be longer and therefore stand out. The one square (right column, center) was punched with the cream yarn but with 2 different loop lengths. You can choose to do the whole square in one setting - you're the artist! :)
  - turn the piece over and take a look at the piece as a whole. Snip ends and beginnings of your stitches. Are there any stitches that are much longer than the rest? If so, snip them just like you would when ending a stitch and mix them in with surrounding stitches so they're not as obvious.
  - straighten out the outline by moving stitches around. Detailed video is [here](#).
