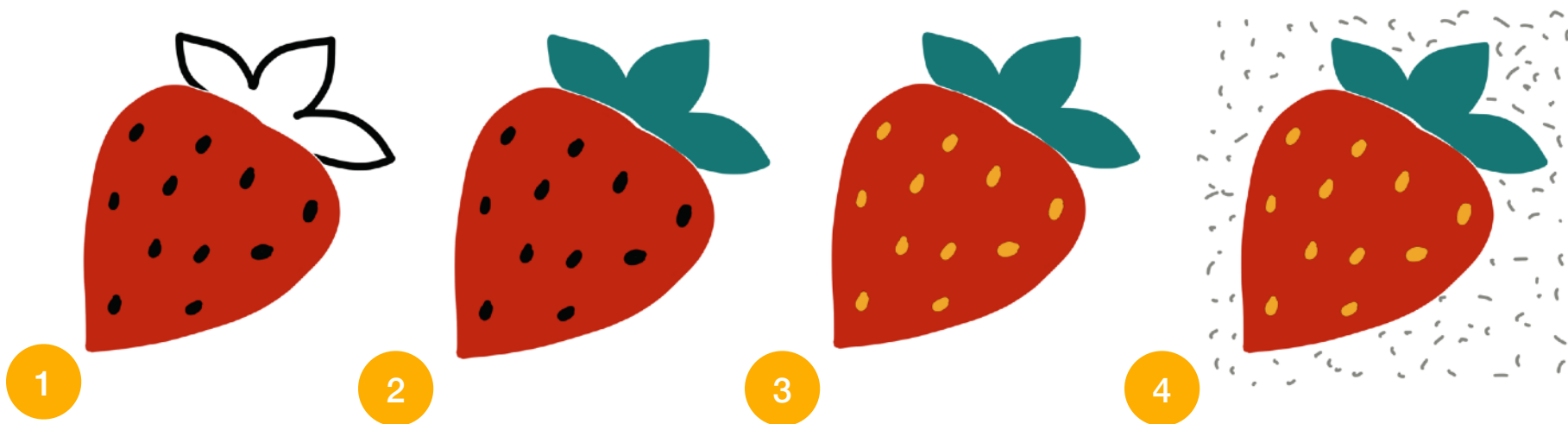




# STRAWBERRY

*instructions*



To complete this kit, I used setting C of the adjustable punch needle. You can play around with the settings to see what you like best. For example, you can make the background shorter or longer to make the strawberry stand out more.

(1) Thread your punch needle with the red yarn and fill out the strawberry.

(2) Thread your punch needle with the green yarn and punch the leaves.

(3) Moving on to yellow yarn. Thread your needle and you have 2 choices - either sew the seeds on from the front, OR punch the seeds in. You don't have to follow the markings exactly, but if you punched with the red yarn all around them you'll be able to see where they are. You'll only need 2 stitches per seed.

(4) Thread the punch needle with the speckled yarn and punch the background.

- turn the piece over and take a look at the piece as a whole. Snip ends and beginnings of your stitches. Are there any stitches that are much longer than the rest? If so, snip them just like you would when ending a stitch and mix them in with surrounding stitches so they're not as obvious.
